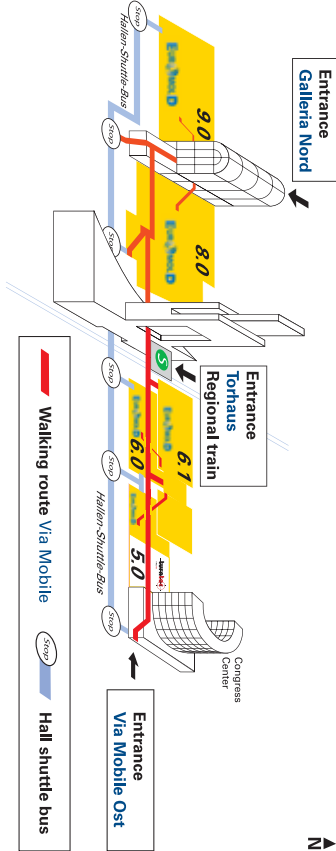

Transport link

The city Frankfurt is in the center of Germany and Europe, provides a well constructed infrastructure. For this reason, you can reach the exhibition center Frankfurt easily.

Arriving by plane

The airport is only 15 km away from the Exhibition Center Frankfurt **taking a cab**

Take the cab directly to Messe Frankfurt, "Entrance Galleria" (hall 9 north side) or "Entrance Friedrich-Ebert-Anlage" .

taking the suburban train

S8 or S9 suburban (direction Hanau) leaves the station below Terminal 1, stopping at the Central Station (the journey takes approx. 10 min.). From there (platform 104) S3, S4, S5, S6 to the station "Messe" (the journey takes approx. 3 min.)

Arriving by car

The A 5 interstate via the Westkreuz Frankfurt interchange takes you directly to Messe Frankfurt. Follow the signposts "Messe Frankfurt" or "Messe". These will take you to the "car park Rebstock", where 15.000 parking lots are located right next to the interstate. From there, a free car park bus will take you to the fair ground.

Arriving by train - Main Station

taking the suburban

From platform 104, take S3, S4, S5, S6 to the "Messe" stop (the journey takes approx. 3 min.). If you want to return to the airport from the Central Station, take S8 or S9 in direction Wiesbaden.

taking the subway

Line U4 leaves for Bockenheimer Warte, stopping at "Festhalle / Messe".

taking the tram

From the railway platform, proceed to the main exit, cross the station forecourt and go to the streetcars. No. 16 and 17 will take you directly to "Festhalle / Messe".

walking on foot

From the Central Station, walk along Düsseldorfer Straße heading towards Platz der Republik. Carry straight on, along Friedrich-Ebert-Anlage, which will lead you directly to the fair grounds (approx. 15 min.)
